Gymnastics Regulation

Each club may register as many athletes as desired by age in each level, 1 trainer and 2 judges for each area (Men's and Women's).

The competition will be individual by category in each level and by club. For the club competition, the top 3 scores for each level for the club will be used to determine the winning club.

All clubs and sports centers that wish to may participate by sending the attached registration sheets.

The age for the participants is the age reached during the period January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2010. A valid passport or birth certificate will be required.

The required programs for USA Gymnastics will regulate the competition along with the PAGU rules for the pertinent levels.

Each club has to present in guarantee of his Federation to can realize the registration.

Uniforms

All athletes should be correctly uniformed with their club emblem according to FIG regulations. Accreditation documents and numbers will be supplied when the registrations fees are canceled.

Judges

Judges must present their International or National cards, attend the technical workshop to be held and use official competition dress with rubber soled shoes.

Awards

All athletes participating will receive certificates of participation. For each event at all levels, 1st 2nd and 3rd places will be awarded gold, silver and bronze medals respectively. 4th to a maximum 10th depending on the number of participants will be awarded bronze medal; 1st 2nd and 3rd places all around will be awarded trophies. Trophies will be awarded to winning clubs.
